**PROTECTIVE MEASURES, RULES OF CONDUCT****Respiratory protection:**

Short term: filter apparatus, filter P3.

Breathing apparatus in the event of high concentrations.

**Hand protection:**

Nitrile rubber, &gt;480 min (EN 374).

**Eye protection:**

Safety glasses.

**Skin protection:**

Light protective clothing.

**Hygiene measures:**

Do not eat, drink, smoke or take drugs at work.

After worktime and before work breaks the affected skin areas must be thoroughly cleaned.

Use barrier skin cream.

Remove soiled clothing.

**BEHAVIOR IN THE CASE OF A DANGER**Phone: **Suitable extinguishing media:**

Sand.

Dry powder.

Metal fire-ex powder.

**Personal precautions:**

Avoid dust formation.

Ensure adequate ventilation.

Use personal protective equipment.

Use breathing apparatus if exposed to dust.

Keep away from all sources of ignition.

**Environmental precautions:**

Do not discharge into the drains/surface waters/groundwater.

**Methods for cleaning up:**

Take up mechanically.

Avoid raising dust.

Dispose of absorbed material in accordance within the regulations.

**Special protective equipment for firefighters:**

Use self-contained breathing apparatus.

**Additional information:**

Do not inhale explosion and/or combustion gases.

Fire residues and contaminated firefighting water must be disposed of in accordance within the local regulations.

Cool containers at risk with water spray jet.

**FIRST AID MEASURES**

<b>General information:</b>	Remove contaminated soaked clothing immediately and dispose of safely.
<b>Inhalation:</b>	Ensure supply of fresh air. Consult a doctor immediately.
<b>Skin contact:</b>	In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water. Supply with medical care.
<b>Eye contact:</b>	In case of contact with eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
<b>Ingestion:</b>	Consult a doctor immediately. Rinse out mouth and give plenty of water to drink.
